

Role Profile - Project Financial Management Consultant

Qualifications – Fully qualified CAAB accountant with a minimum 3 years PQE.

Experience – FTSE 250 or senior public sector experience. Strong financial control background together with experience in industry/commerce. You will have been a financial manager or controller for large global multi-project implementations. You will have shown your ability to control project costs v budgets and deliver on target financial management. Knowledge and experience of information systems implementations, be able to show your experience of project management within a commercial organisation. Ownership, creation and delivery of business performance reporting packages and presentations. Proven track record in fast-moving commercial settings. Excellent technical accounting and systems skills are essential. As are solid communication qualities to all levels of the organization.

Responsibilities - Development and improvement of project financial management systems and processes. Managing a small, dedicated project operational accounting team. Provision of coaching, training and consultancy across a range of project financial requirements.
